NURSE

Notified of possible symptoms

- Nurses evaluate individuals for potential isolation.
- Nurses contact home.

Nurses notified of + COVID-19

- Nurses interview individual for Close Contacts list.
- Close contact letter provided to individuals and/or families as needed.
- Student placed in quarantine room until parent pickup.
- Notify administration with the provided template.
- Nurses follow up with reporting to Cook County Department of Health.

CONTACT TRACING



SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

- AP1 Contact tracing begins

 pull students' / staff's schedule
 and compile a list of teachers
 and students who could be close contacts.
 - Exposure letters sent to parents and affected students.
- AP2 notifies attendance and counselors, and authorizes students for remote learning.
- ★●AP3 notifies ABM and provides room locations for sanitation, ISO room is disinfected daily.
- Principal notifies immediate teachers, departments, and staff as a whole.

SCHOOL PREP




QUARANTINED

 Provided expectations for Google Classroom with notification for students that are quarantined. AP2 notifies staff of classes that must be broadcasted on Google.



 Nurses follow up with quarantined students and families the day before expected return.

COMPLETION



NURSE

- Nurses submit weekly reports to their immediate supervisor.
- Nurses confer with Cook County Department of Public Health on issues of outbreaks and adaptive pauses.



 Submit required documentation to Cook County Department of Public Health.
