## THE SHOULD

I TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19?

1) Stay home for 10 days from onset of symptoms or from positive test result - whether or not you are having symptoms!

> 2) Report illness to your school nurse

After 10 DAYS and if COVID test is negative, you may return to school with written permission from D205, plus no fever for 24 hours without fever reducing medication and no remaining symptoms.

I HAVE HAD CLOSE CONTACT\* WITH A COVID-19 CASE?

> I have been fully vaccinated

I am not fully vaccinated

1) Report close contact to your school nurse.

2) No quarantine is necessary if no COVID-19-like symptoms are being experienced. You may attend school.

3) COVID test recommended 3-5 days after exposure.

- 1) Stay home!
- 2) Report illness to your school nurse.
- 3) May return to school after a 14-DAY quarantine from last contact. plus written permission from D205.

recommended

\*CLOSE CONTACT

IS DEFINED AS BEING WITHIN 6 FEET OF A COVID-19 POSTITIVE CASE FOR AT LEAST 15 MINUTES OVER A 24-HOUR PERIOD.

**EXCEPTION: IN A CLASSROOM - THIS EXCLUDES STUDENTS WHO WERE WITHIN 3-6 FEET IF BOTH INDIVIDUALS WERE PROPERLY MASKED.** 

Note: The length of exclusion from school will be determined on a case by case basis per IDPH guidelines.
