District 205 Parents of Juniors (Class of 2017),

As you may know, assessments have changed significantly in the State of Illinois over the past year. For many years, our juniors have been tested using the PSAE (Prairie State Achievement Exam) which consisted of the ACT and the WorkKeys tests. Last year, we began our transition towards the PARCC assessment. However, our juniors were still able to take the ACT in addition to the PARCC.

This year, we will continue with PARCC (online) testing. More specific information regarding dates and students who will be assessed will be forthcoming.

The purpose of this communication is to let you know that there is a possibility that our juniors will not have the opportunity to take the ACT in the spring. Until the State of Illinois releases their budget, we will not know for sure. If students do not test in the spring as they have in the past, students will need to take the ACT on their own on a National Testing Day. The dates, deadlines, and information are below.
